Star Testing Report

Parents will receive an information parent letter about the STAR testing and a copy of a custom STAR Parent Report which explains your child's scores. Students who score in the intervention or urgent intervention areas will also receive an Instructional Planning Report. It is important to remember that this test is a snapshot of how your child did on this particular day and time on this assessment measure. Your child's teacher will be able to provide additional information on your child's day to day performance and learning. These reports will be sent home with report cards on Nov. 11 and discussed at parent teacher conferences.

Report Cards

The first quarter marking report cards were sent home on 11/11. This reports your child's progress in all areas and provides information for you about your child's learning. This report card template has been provided by the AOD. The AOD is finalizing a standardized report card for all Catholic schools which should be released for Q2. If you have any questions about the report card, please contact your child's teacher.

A little act of kindness can go a long way to brighten someone's day. What kind act will you do on November 13th to bring a smile to someone's face?

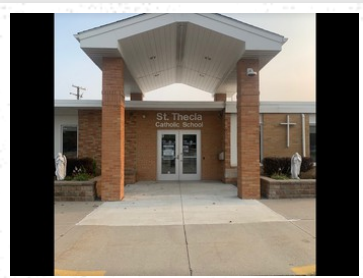
