Dear St. Thecla Families,

Uniforms- Grades K-8

Some of the areas that need the most attention are:

- appropriate skirt/jumper length for all grades (not shorter that 2 inches above the knee)
- gym uniform- appropriate sweatpants, shirts, color (no logos other than St. Thecla)
- jewelry (religious, post earrings)
- make up (not allowed), including finger nail polish
- hair length for boys
