We hope you enjoyed your mid winter break! it didn't take us long to get back into the routine of school and the fun of learning! This school news is being delivered early today due to some difficult news I need to share.

Dear St. Thecla Families,

I have sad news to share with you as one St. Thecla family has experienced a tragedy. Mr. Erwin Angala, father to Penny (grade 7) and Pablo (grade 2), and husband to Cortney, died last night due to medical complications following surgeries.

I don't have the words to share how profoundly sad I am. This wonderful family has been a part of our St. Thecla community for years. Each of us feels a unique pain when a life is lost. I know that sharing this terrible news with you via email isn't the best way for you to learn of this, but I thought it was necessary that you had this information today. Due to this information being communicated within our small, close knit community last evening, the information of Mr. Angala's death was shared with students in 2nd through 8th grade today. Their teachers and I were (and are) available for support and to answer questions. At this time, the Angala family appreciates your respect for their privacy and for keeping them in your thoughts and prayers. I will keep you updated as plans develop.

One of the best ways we can help our children is to maintain daily routines, while supporting them with any questions they might have. If you notice that your child(ren), or any others, need additional support, please inform the teacher or myself.

We will also inform you by email, text alerts through FACTS, and radio and television alerts..

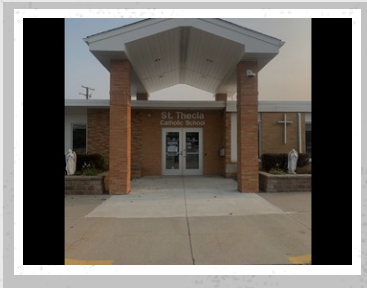
