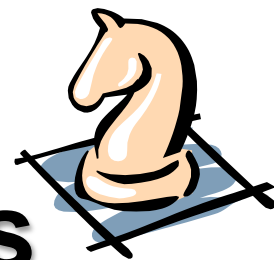


St. Thecla Chess Club/Class
